7th & 8th grade families are asked to bring in baked goods on Saturday or on Sunday by 7:30 a.m.

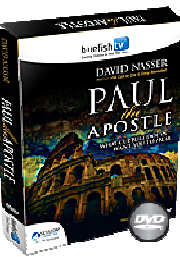
